Ikeda preserves the legend of Orihime, a weaving princess, said to have introduced textile weaving to Japan. Sites associated with Orihime can be found throughout the city.

Ikeda is also the birthplace of the world's first instant ramen, invented here by Momofuku Ando, founder of Nissin Foods. The Cupnoodles Museum Osaka Ikeda shares the story of this invention and offers hands-on experiences.



Ichizo Kobayashi, founder of the Hankyu Toho Group, developed an innovative model for residential development here.

Visitors can still tour related sites, including his former residence.

For these reasons, Ikeda is known as a city where new ideas, culture, and innovative systems have taken shape.


# Experience Nature at Satsukiyama

## ACCESS

### < By Train >

#### ● From Osaka :

About 19 minutes direct from Hankyu Osaka-Umeda Station to Ikeda Station, or about 16 minutes direct to Ishibashi Handai-mae Station


#### ● From Osaka Itami Airport :

About 14 minutes from Osaka Monorail Osaka Airport Station to Hankyu Ikeda Station, or about 11 minutes to Ishibashi Handai-mae Station

#### ● To the Hosokawa Area :

About 15 minutes by car from Hankyu Ikeda Station; immediately accessible from the Hanshin Expressway Ikeda-Kibe Exit  
Alternatively, take the Hankyu Bus from Bus Stop No. 2 at Ikeda Station bound for Fushiodai or Yono.

## Satsukiwama/Hosokawa/Fushiodai Area

A lush area rich in nature and history.

Enjoy peaceful surroundings close to the city center.



**1 Kyuanji Temple**

A temple known for seasonal flowers. The Sanmon Gate is an Important Cultural Property.



**2 Hot Springs Hotel FUSHIOUKAKU**

A hot spring inn offering day-use bathing.



**3 Satsukiwama Ryokuchi Urban Greening Botanical Garden**

A botanical garden with greenhouses and exhibitions.



**4 Satsukiwama Zoo**

A small zoo famous for wombats. Closed for renovation as of February 2026.



**5 Satsukiwama Children's Cultural Center**

A community facility with a planetarium.



**6 Ikeda Jinja Shrine**

The city's oldest shrine, associated with the legend of Orihime.



**7 Ikeda Castle Ruins Park**

A park with gardens and an observation deck.



## Satsukiwama/Hosokawa/Fushiodai Area

A central district where history and shopping come together.

Ideal for an easy and enjoyable stroll.



**8 Rakugo Museum**

A museum dedicated to rakugo (traditional comic storytelling).



**9 Ikeda Gofukuza**

A popular theater with daily performances (closed on some days).



**10 Kobayashi Ichizo Memorial House**

Former residence and museum of the entrepreneur Ichizo Kobayashi.



**11 Itsuo Art Museum**

An art museum exhibiting crafts and fine art.



**12 Ikeda Bunko Library**

A library specializing in performing arts materials.



**13 Seiseien**

A café and specialty shop area in renovated traditional houses.



**14 Sakaemachi Shopping Street**

A lively shopping street leading toward Satsukiwama.



**15 Cupnoodles Museum Osaka Ikeda**

A museum where visitors can try their hand at making instant ramen.



**16 Kureha Jinja Shrine**

A shrine connected to Orihime, the legendary weaving princess.



## Ishibashi Area

A lively district popular with students.

Close to Osaka Itami Airport, the station area allows visitors to experience the local atmosphere on foot.



**17 Suigetsu Park**

A park known for flowers and Chinese-style architecture.



**18 Ishibashi Shopping Street**

A vibrant shopping street popular with students.



**19 Osaka Itami Airport**

Features an observation deck for close-up airplane views.



**20 DAIHATSU Humobility World**

An exhibition facility introducing the history and technology of automobiles.
